Our general impression of the hotel was good. It is spacious and light with ample seating areas by the bar and restaurant, which is on the ground floor close to the Reception area. The food we sampled was acceptable and the staff pleasant and attentive

CONFERENCE AREAS



The Conference area is on the first floor and has plenty of natural light. The main room and break out rooms will serve our purpose.



CATERING



1. Tea and coffee will be available on the ground floor on arrival and during tea and coffee breaks
2. Lunch on both days will be a buffet style meal with hot and cold dishes with a vegetarian choice
3. On the Thursday evening dinner will be served in a room for the exclusive use of AVSM. It will be a set three course meal with a vegetarian option. A cash bar will be open until 1am.

ACCOMMODATION

The rooms are of a good standard and similar to last year. We are likely to be accommodated on the top floors which are quieter but anybody needing a lower floor room or one with disabled facilities will be given something on a lower floor.

Some toiletries are in all rooms but delegates may wish to bring shower caps.

Check out is midday



ADDITIONAL ROOMS

For delegates wishing to stay the night before Conference or extend their stay they will need to contact the hotel direct. There is a variable rate dependent on how many rooms are available.
